- are registered/work in one of the Latin American Higher Education Institutions member of the partnership
- have obtained a university degree or equivalent by an institution of these Countries (students only)
- are registered/work in a higher education institution of these countries that
 is not included in the partnership (students and staff) or have obtained a university
 degree or equivalent by an institution of these countries (students only)
